



Brentford School for Girls is a member of the Cycle to Work Scheme, which offers you a fantastic opportunity to save money on the purchase of a bike and accessories and to enjoy the freedom and all the added health benefits of cycling to work!

Cycle to work operates as a 'salary sacrifice' employee benefit. The saving is achieved by paying for the bike and/or accessories directly from your gross salary (before tax). This means your income tax and national insurance are based on your salary less the cost of the bike and/or accessories. Hence, the amount of tax and national insurance you pay is less.

You can calculate how much your monthly deduction will be by inputting the value of bike you would like, your salary and period of repayment; all you need is your payroll number. It is important to research the bike you would like before you start and to know which retailer you would like to use.
